Dear Parents/Caregivers

Welcome to Term 4 2022. I hope you kept safe over the break and enjoyed some quality time with loved ones. Term 4 holds some very important and exciting learning opportunities for your child and rounds out their Primary School years. Throughout the term, the Year 6 students will participate in further high school transition visits and will of course have their graduation celebration at the end of the term. The Year 5 students will be having their swimming lessons Monday to Friday in week 5. The Year 6 students will be placed in different classes for the time we are away and will have work to complete.

We are now over half way through your child's final year in primary school! Homework and Reading

As with last term, students are expected to complete nightly homework. This comprises of 15 minutes of reading, maths activities, plus any incomplete work from the day's lessons. This term, we are asking that students use their diaries to create a record log of their reading progress.

Homework must be at school, completed and ready for marking every Friday morning otherwise your child will miss out on bonus free time and play time until work is completed.

Please make sure students are at school as much as possible and if a student stays home then they should be checking Class Dojo to see what work needs to be completed.

I would like to reiterate some classroom expectations as we enter the new term:

- ⇒ students need to arrive at school for the beginning bell at 8:35am
- ⇒ all students require their stationery and other materials necessary to learn
- ⇒ remember to check Class Dojo for regular updates on your child's learning and any important reminders
- ⇒ hats are to be worn all year round
